Sky Dancer

Screening and Discussion with the Director

Sky Dancer shares with audiences the simple yet profound teachings of Khandroma Kunzang Wangmo, a nomadic woman from a remote area of the Tibetan plateau. Khandroma is a learned and respected woman teacher, or "lama", a rare position for a woman in Asia. Compelled to preserve the teachings imparted to her by her father, and to continue the lineage of her great grand-father Dudjom Lingpa, Khandroma has gained many Chinese Buddhist followers. At a time of great transition in China, she illuminates a sense of humanity which unites people from all backgrounds.

Jody Kemmerer's documentary about Khandroma Kunzang Wangmo stems from her interest in Tibet began in 2000 when she visited a Tibetan refugee settlement in Dharmasala, India. Jody immediately recognized the unique wisdom Tibetan culture offers humanity. Shortly thereafter she met her teacher, a lama still residing in Tibet, and began to work closely under him to help support monasteries, monastic colleges, primary schools, health clinics and retreat centers in a remote region of Eastern Tibet. Over the last seven years she has hosted many of his visits to the United States, bringing his Tibetan Buddhist teachings to Western audiences. Jody Kemmerer is also working on the Tibetan Woman's Health Initiative, a program aimed at lowering the high mortality rates among new mothers and infants in Tibet.
